Within the Renaissance château of Villers-Cotterêts, built in 1532 by Francis I and entirely restored, the International centre for French Language aims to allow as many people as possible to share and enjoy this modern, living language, which is constantly being reinvented by French speakers all over the world.

Its 1,200m² visitor circuit, its rich cultural programme on display in the temporary exhibition rooms, its auditorium, its courtyards and gardens, its café and bookshop, and much more make the Centre a site open to all against a unique lush backdrop: the Forest of Retz.

DID YOU KNOW...?

It was here, in 1539, that Francis I signed the Ordinance of Villers-Cotterêts making the use of the French language compulsory in administrative and legal acts.
